

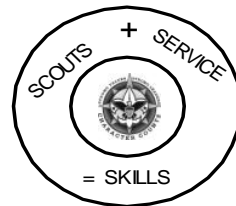

SCOUTMASTERS: In order to have a smooth running, successful day for our scouts, we need your help!

1. Copy this flyer and give it to each of your scouts and your adult committee.
2. Inform your scouts they **MUST** read the requirements in the latest merit badge book of their choice first, & then call the counselor for further requirements. Counselors have the right to refuse admission to any scout who has not called &/or prepared properly.
3. Furnish your scouts with a **blue merit badge application card** (the blue application paper form is fine). The scout must bring this card to Merit Badge Day, filled out and **signed by you** on the front only, under the Scout's name and address.
4. Make sure your scouts are prepared for the merit badges they choose, **before** coming to Merit Badge Day.
5. Please encourage your scouts to wear their **FULL "CLASS A" UNIFORM** on Merit Badge Day.

SCOUTS: In order to have a smooth running, successful day for you, we need your help! **Boy Scout Motto: BE PREPARED!**

1. Choose 1 merit badge in the morning & 1 badge in the afternoon, more if well prepared. Note classes with 2 sessions (All-Day).
2. **Read** the **MOST RECENT edition pamphlet/book** for the merit badge(s) of your choice; newest year is listed by badge name.
3. **You, the SCOUT (not Mom or Dad), CALL THE COUNSELOR IMMEDIATELY!!** to register/reserve a spot in that class!
Ask the counselor questions about prerequisites & any pens/pencils, paperwork, projects, equipment, etc. you need to bring. The prerequisites listed in this packet, plus any other things the counselor tells you about, must be **completed by you before MB Day**.
4. **Prepare:** Read! Re-read! Do the badge Prerequisites. Fill out any worksheets you want to download.
5. Find/Wear a **FULL SCOUT UNIFORM. CAMOUFLAGE, SWEATS, AND T-SHIRTS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE AND YOU WILL BE SENT HOME. COMPLETE UNIFORMS ONLY.** (not Sash; that's for Boards of Review & Courts of Honor.)
6. Get a **BLUE** merit badge **CARD** from your Scoutmaster; ask Scoutmaster to **SIGN it; bring card** with you on Merit Badge Day.
To the SCOUT: YOU write your Name, Address, Troop#, District name, & Council name SO WE CAN READ IT!
7. **Bring the pamphlet** (Merit Badge book) with you on Merit Badge Day.
8. Remember: Classes close after the first 5 minutes. Please be on time, or better yet, BE EARLY!
9. **All cell phones must be off during sessions!**
10. **CHECK IN** at Registration Table (inside large recreation hall) when you arrive. If coming for PM only, register/pay in Kitchen.
FEE \$10.00 includes lunch and is to pay for material costs & excess to help support Troop summer camps.
Hamburger & hot dog, chips, drink, cookie. Fee is the same, whether eating lunch or not, or coming half day.

A Scout can earn merit badges as schedules & prior preparation permit. Merit badges can be finished (signed-off) if you are prepared. "Partials" will be given if you have not done the requirements; save card, to be completed later. Don't leave class without your Blue Card! **Take completed blue card(s) to Scoutmaster for a 2nd signature, then to Advancement Chair who records & purchases badges!**

Pre-register with individual badge counselors by April 7th; classes close fast (space for approximately 10 per class).

(IF A SCOUT DID NOT PRE-REGISTER, HE MAY STILL ATTEND ANY SESSION WITH THE PERMISSION OF THE MERIT BADGE COUNSELOR.)

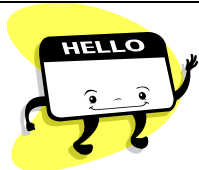

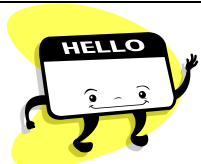
